Membership of The Fire Brigade Society

Membership of The Fire Brigade Society is open to everyone, regardless of age, gender, religion, disability, race or location. The Society is a not for profit organisation, with all income being used to provide member services and benefits. The Society is totally non-political.

Although the majority of members are located in the UK, there are over 50 members in other countries around the world including Ireland, Belgium, Germany, Holland, Malta, Spain, Denmark, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand, Canada and the United States. The Society is currently working to improve the coverage of non-UK fire & rescue services and more overseas members can only help this aim.

Members benefit from The Society's highly acclaimed magazine – Fire Cover – which is published 4 times a year; special publications which are published to mark particular events or subjects, access to appliance fleet lists (currently UK only); access to The Society Library and archives; visits to local fire & rescue services, including the Annual General Meeting and National Visit weekends; and excellent networking opportunities.

There is a range of membership categories, to suit all members, which are detailed below:

Ordinary Membership is the category that is appropriate for the majority of people. There are 3 options depending solely on your location. The increased cost for overseas members is due to the additional postage charges for Fire Cover.

Ordinary Membership (UK & Islands). This option is for people located within England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man and the Channel Islands. The current annual membership subscription is £29

Ordinary Membership (EU & Republic of Ireland). This option is for people located within European Union countries, including the Republic of Ireland. The current annual membership subscription is £31

Ordinary Membership (Rest of the World). This option is for people located in any country not covered by the above categories. The current annual membership subscription is £36

Junior Membership – this membership option is available to young people aged less than 16 years of age, resident in the UK only. The current annual membership subscriptions is £18

Associate Membership – this membership is only available to close family members who live at the same address as an Ordinary member. Associate members are able to attend visits but only when their ordinary member accompanies them; Associate members do not receive their own copy of Fire Cover. The current annual cost of membership is £3

Payment may be made by cheque, money order or postal order, made payable to THE FIRE BRIGADE SOCIETY. Alternatively payment may be able to be made by standing order, direct debit, bank transfer and PayPal, however the options do vary by location and will be advised accordingly. Overseas payments must be in sterling (GBP). Full details can be found on the website: www.thefirebrigadesociety.co.uk
