MEMBERSHIP UPDATE No 3 - FEBRUARY 2023

Issued by the Society Management Team (SMT)

Dear Members.

Happy New Year to you and your families.

In the last membership update (December 2022) we asked for your opinions on two subjects and made a plea for some urgent assistance. The first question we asked concerned Fire Cover, we asked for your views regarding Fire Cover becoming an electronic online publication only if finances did not allow for a printed version. The response from members was disappointing, only 26 responded. The majority of those who responded would accept an online Fire Cover as a last resort but would prefer to keep a hard copy even if subscription rates had to rise.

Our second request concerned membership renewals; we asked if any of you had already decided not to renew to let us know so that we had a rough idea what the financial situation may be. The good news is only 2 members have confirmed that they will not be renewing.

Our plea for assistance was for volunteers to form a new Editorial team. I am delighted to announce that a new Editorial team has been appointed as from Fire Cover 239 and will consist of Andy Daley as Lead Editor, assisted by Graham Brown, Harry Copsey, David Mitchell, Steve Udall and Gavin Stewart. This is great news and we thank Andy and his team for offering to take on these important positions. All material for Fire Cover should be either emailed to tobsfirecover@gmail.com or sent to Andy at 120 Lincombe Road, Huyton, Liverpool, L36 2LS.

Please remember without members submitting articles and photographs there will not be a Fire Cover.

In October 2022 we issued an update including a Statement of Intent 2023/2024 which detailed what the SMT would like to achieve during the course of the 2023/2024 membership year. I am pleased to confirm, subject to increases in production costs remaining as indicated, enough material being submitted and postage rates not increasing to an unsustainable level we will continue with our plan of producing 3 Fire Cover's during the membership year and in addition we will be commissioning a special publication to celebrate the 60th anniversary of the Society which will be sent free of charge to every full and Honorary Life Member with the October edition of Fire Cover.

We are only able to commit to this expenditure due to the cost saving initiatives the SMT have introduced and the significant donations we have received from members over the past 12 months. Our Treasurer Richard Thompson commented on our financial position - The society's finances are of no cause for concern this year. The first year of the revised membership rates have meant we always planned to, at least, break even. While we have seen a slight reduction in the number of members, we have also seen a reduction in the number of editions of Fire Cover down to three per membership year. Efforts have also gone in this year to sell off all of the Sales Unit stock. This has given us a welcome one-off boost to income.

What we could not have predicted was the amazingly high level of donations given. A number of members have been showing how much they value the FBS by giving generous donations. The individuals will remain anonymous but they have been individually thanked. Overall, this has meant that we are forecasting a significant surplus for 2022-23. The financial picture of the Society at the end of quarter 3 (31 December 2022) is included in Fire Cover 238.

If you are receiving this update by email, you will also have received an attachment containing the 2023/2024 membership renewal form. For members receiving a hard copy update, you will have received a hard copy renewal form. Please don't delay, return your renewal as soon as possible.

Please remember we have revised payment options, bank transfer, cheque, postal order or cash are the <u>only</u> methods of payment now accepted. For those of you who previously paid by standing order or direct debit, please ensure these are cancelled with your bank or building society.

Those members who supply an email address will receive an email confirming your renewal form has been received, for members without an email address, if you require confirmation of receipt of your renewal form, please send a stamped addressed envelope.

Please also remember that as previously advised we will not be issuing membership cards this year.
